List of Sins, Vices, Spirits, or Attitudes/Strong Emotions/Dispositions

<u>Underline</u> all that applies to you. If some of these have subsided over the years, but were strong at one time, underline them anyway. Temptations come from the world, the flesh, and the devil. We sin when we purposely "hold on" to these temptations. It is possible that you may have some strong negative mental attitudes, or that you are being tempted by the devil, or both at the same time. God wants to free you from selfish worldly thinking, the weakness of the flesh, and from oppression.

These sins, attitudes, etc. usually show up in groups, so you will see some repeated information. For example, you will see "passivity" listed in numbers 11 and 12.

At our prayer session, you will be praying something like: "In the name of Jesus Christ, and by the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, St Michael, St. Joseph, and ____, ___, ___, I renounce the spirits of ____." [To repeat a sentence, say: "A second time in the name of Jesus."]

Occult Involvement

One of Satan's favorite weapons against us is occult involvement. Occult involvement means trying to seek supernatural knowledge or power from a spiritual source other than God. This involvement breaks the first commandment and causes spiritual confusion. Satan does not care if we knew what we were doing or not; he uses anything to trick us.

There are many Scripture passages that forbid occult participation. For example, **Dt 18:10-12** states: "Let there not be found among you anyone who immolates his son or daughter in the fire, nor a fortune-teller, soothsayer, charmer, diviner, or caster of spells, nor one who consults ghosts and spirits or seeks oracles from the dead. Anyone who does such things is an abomination to the LORD...." Also, see **Isa 47:11-15**, **Acts 19:18-20**, and **2 Thes 2:9-11**.

After looking at the questionnaire that follows, if you have been involved in any of these practices listed below, please go to the <u>Sacrament of Reconciliation</u>, if you never confessed these things. Also, pray this prayer for each occult thing before seeing our team:

"In the name of Jesus Christ and by the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, I renounce the spirit of _____ (e.g., fortune telling, horoscope, etc.), and in His name, I break its power and cancel its effects."

As you look at the questionnaire, notice that not everything on the list is of equal importance. Having a rabbit's foot as a kid is not the same as joining a coven. Someone who joined a coven will probably need Reconciliation and deliverance; whereas the person with the rabbit's foot can tell the priest in Confession that he/she wasted the Lord's time with superstition. Do not be afraid! Fear is not of God. God is here to forgive and liberate you.

Have there been any occult contacts or involvement in your personal life or family history? Consider the questions carefully. Any occult involvement may be causing some oppression.

You may see something such as yoga, reflexology, or something else that you think should not be on the below questionnaire. Please be open (don't be rigid) and think about the dangers or risks involved in yoga, reflexology, etc. by checking out the website: http://www.womenofgrace.com/blog/?cat=6482.

Or search "womenofgrace.com." Then click on "blog" in the menu bar. Then click on "blog index by subject" under New Age on the right side. Note: Some of the items listed on this website are not part of the occult; they just have explanations to questions about certain topics.

<u>Prayer before the examination</u>: Come, Holy Spirit. Please bring to my mind every involvement I have ever had with the occult. I choose to humble myself and allow You to guide, direct, and help me to be completely honest as I consider these questions. I submit myself to You in Jesus' most holy name. Amen.

5. Have you ever practiced yoga or done exercises related to yoga or tai chi or practiced transcendental meditation? See the "Women of Grace" website or search "dangers of yoga."

7. Have you ever had a life or reincarnate reading?

8. Have you ever played with a Ouija board, "Guiding Light Angel Board," etc.?

9. Have you ever consulted a medium or numerologist?

12. Have you, or has anyone for you, practiced water witching, using a twig or pendulum?

13. Have you read or do you possess books on astrology, fortune telling, or new age practices? Have you accepted the writings of Edgar Cayce? Do you read and/or watch *Harry Potter* or the *Twilight* series? 14. Have you played with occult games such as ESP, telepathy, Kabala, Dungeons and Dragons? Have you played "Bloody Mary" or "Charlie, Charlie" ("pencil game")?

15. Have you ever "thought" at a person or tried to make them call or write you by your thoughts? 16. Have you ever sought healing through magic, charming, or crystals, psychic healing or surgery, Reiki, hypnosis, metaphysical healing, use of the pendulum or trance for diagnosis, reflexology, acupuncture, or any other occult means? 17. 29. Have you ever listened to hard rock music for long periods of time? Do you have strong identification with a musician, dead or alive?

30. Do you have strong identification with a movie star or famous figure, dead or alive?

31. Have you or any family member, present or deceased, belonged to the Freemasons, DeMolay, Eastern Star, Rainbow Girls, Job's Daughters, Shriners? Have you been involved in a lodge or organization requiring rituals for membership? 32. Do you see auras?
