

Fatima Prayer Cell Prayer Sheet (6 Nov 23)

[Leader chooses 5 volunteers—1 for each decade.]

+In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Leader: We raise up our prayers this evening through Mary's Immaculate Heart, with St. Michael, St. Joseph, St. John 23, and the rest of our Patron Saints and Guardian Angels.

Leader: Take the next 20 seconds of silence to tell God what you are thankful for.

Leader: Now take 20 seconds of silence to tell God what you are asking for. Please include conversion of CSU students and those who attend St. John 23.

Leader: Gathered together in a heartfelt spirit of prayer, penance, and reparation for sin in response to the urgent requests of Our Lady of Fatima, and united in fraternal affection and purpose with all members of World Apostolate of Fatima Prayer Cells throughout the world, we pray for the following intentions:

Leader: For the salvation of souls—for our own souls; for those of our families and friends; for those of all members of the World Apostolate of Fatima; and especially for those of poor sinners who have no one to make reparation for their sins or pray for their conversion, we pray...

Response: O Lord, save us all.

Leader: For world peace: that as people turn away from sin and back to God peace may come to them, to their families, to their nations and to the world, we pray...

Response: O Lord, bring us peace.

Leader: For the guidance and protection of Holy Mother Church—the Bark of Peter—as She sails upon the stormy seas caused by sin and corruption in the world striving to fulfill Her sacred mission as the instrument of the grace of salvation for all, we pray...

Response: O Lord, guide and protect your Church.

Leader: That the Pope will follow completely the guidance of the Holy Spirit, so that He may assist him in manning the helm of Peter's Bark, and for special graces for all those united with the Pope in carrying out the true mission of the Church, we pray...

Response: O Lord, guide and console them.

Leader: For those suffering from all manner of physical, emotional or other ailments, that they may

recognize the redemptive value of their suffering, offer it in reparation for sin; and, God-willing, be restored to good health, we pray...

Response: O Lord, console them and heal them.

Leader: For all members of the World Apostolate of Fatima, that they remain faithful in honoring Our Lady's requests and steadfast in their commitment to spreading Her message, we pray...

Response: O Lord, keep us faithful and strengthen our resolve.

Leader: For all victims of the consequences of sin—for the suffering souls in purgatory; for those enduring the plagues of war; for those suffering from the greed and injustice of others; for those mired in lives of sexual deviancy and drug and alcohol addiction and their loved ones adversely affected; and for those holy innocents living in the wombs of mothers contemplating abortion, we pray...

Response: O Lord, send your angels to guide, protect, and console us.

Leader: For the triumph of the Immaculate Heart of Mary; that soon there will be sufficient numbers of souls drawn away from sin and into Her Immaculate Heart and the Heart of Her Son so that the souls of many will be saved and the era of peace She promised to the world will at last come to fruition, we pray...

Response: O Lord, grant us the grace of devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Your Mother and to Your own Sacred Heart.

Leader: For these and for all the intentions of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary and in reparation for the sins committed against them, we pray...

Response: O Lord, bring conversion to sinners and peace to the world.

Leader: Father, we ask for all of these favors through the intercession of Our Lady of Fatima, and in the name of Jesus Christ, Your Son, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, God, forever and ever.

Response: Amen.

1. Leader: May the graces of the first Joyful Mystery, the Annunciation, come down into our souls. We ask for the virtue of humility.

-Volunteer 1: Meditation: The love of God descended upon all humanity when the power of the Most High came upon Mary. It is in Mary that the Word was made Flesh, and it is through Mary that we receive the graces He wishes to grant us. Let us, with the Heart of Mary, open our hearts to receive *in faith* the love He wishes to pour into our souls. 1 OF, 10 HM

-**Glory be...**

-**O my Jesus**, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell; lead all souls to Heaven, especially those in most need of Thy Mercy.

-**My God**, I believe, I adore, I hope, and I love You. I beg pardon for those who do not believe, do not adore, do not hope, and do not love You.

-Sing: **Ave**, ave, ave, Maria; ave, ave, ave, Maria.

2. Leader: May the graces of the second Joyful Mystery, the Visitation, come down into our souls. We ask for the virtue of love of neighbor.

-Volunteer 2: Meditation: Mary's faith brought our Savior to us. Her visit to Elizabeth was a sharing of the gift and promise God had entrusted to Her. Our Lady's Magnificat is Her Heart's proclamation of God's goodness to those who trust that the Word of the Lord would be fulfilled. Let us always proclaim the greatness of the Lord, and our spirit will rejoice in God our Savior. 1 OF, 10 HM

-Glory be...O my Jesus...My God...Ave

3. Leader: May the graces of the third Joyful Mystery, the Birth of Jesus, come down into our souls. We ask for the virtue of detachment.

-Volunteer 3: Meditation: In fulfilling the duties of their state in life, Mary and Joseph obey Caesar's decree, bearing patiently with the sufferings and inconveniences this journey entailed. Out of this silent suffering was born our Lord, Who came to be with us, and to accompany us through our own daily trials and sufferings, with a promise of peace. 1 OF, 10 HM

-Glory be...O my Jesus...My God...Ave

4. Leader: May the graces of the fourth Joyful Mystery, The Presentation of Jesus in the Temple, come down into our souls. We ask for the virtue of obedience.

-Volunteer 4: Meditation: Mary and Joseph presented Jesus in the Temple according to the prescriptions of the law. Marvel with them at Simeon's revelations of what Jesus would accomplish during His life—a glory and tragedy to be fulfilled, both then and today: a light

to those who are separated from Him, and the glory of His people, the New Israel; yet also a sign of contradiction through divisions found among us—the same sword which pierces the soul of Mary today.

5. Leader: May the graces of the fifth Joyful Mystery, The Finding of the Child Jesus in the Temple, come down into our souls. We ask for the virtue of greater commitment and devotion to Jesus.

-Volunteer 5: Meditation: Seeking Him, Mary and Joseph find Jesus on the third day. The anxiety during two days of searching turned into elation when they finally found Him on the third. They were amazed at where He was and at what He was doing. Another loss and finding would come later—an event which Mary would forever ponder in Her Heart: Jesus' Death and Resurrection. This loss is one that we should never forget, lest we lose Him forever.

Act of Consecration

Therefore, we now promise to imitate Thy virtues by the practice of a Christian life without regard to human respect. We resolve to receive Holy Communion on the first Saturday of every month and to offer Thee five decades of the Rosary each day together with our sacrifices in a spirit of reparation and penance.
